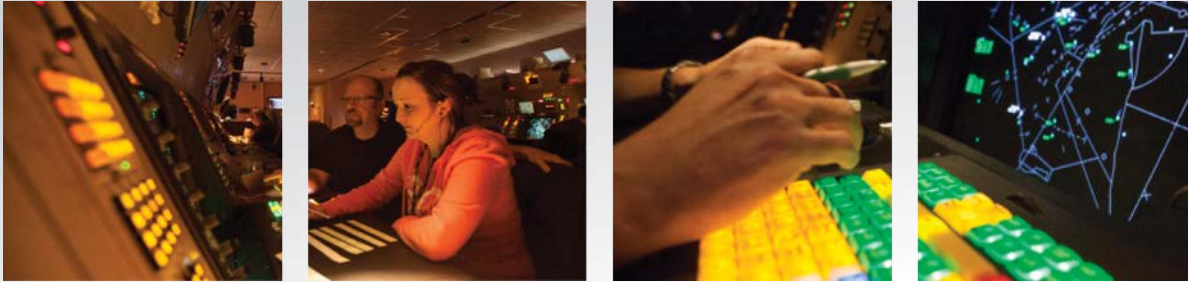

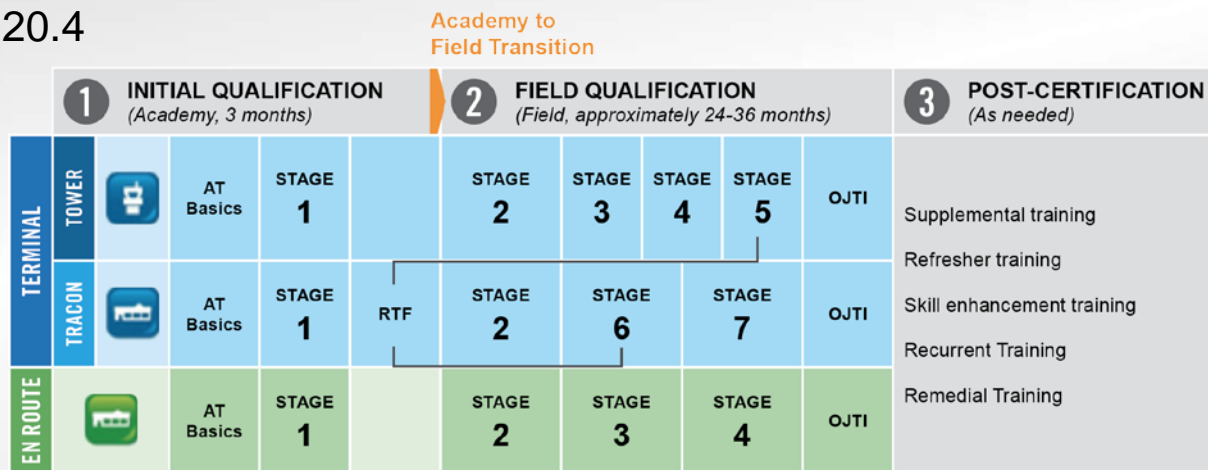
Delivery of Training to Air Traffic Controllers: Current State of Air Traffic

Order

- FAA Order JO 3120.4 for Air Traffic Controllers

Disciplines

- Tower
- Tracon
- En Route/
Oceanic
- Flight Service
Station (FSS)



Delivery of Training to Air Traffic Controllers: Current State of Air Traffic

Technical Training for Certification

- Basic Stage 1 Training
- Stage 2 through 7 Training delivered at field facilities via classroom and simulation (where available)
- Stage 6 RTF must return to Academy
- On-the-Job Training

Post-Certification Training

- Recurrent is developed based off of safety data
- Advanced training is inconsistent with the need (includes NextGen equipment and procedures across all domains)

Delivery of Training to Air Traffic Controllers: Future State of Air Traffic

Order

- 3120.4 for Air Traffic Controllers

Disciplines

- Tower
- Tracon
- En Route/Oceanic
- Flight Service Station (FSS)

Technical Training for Certification

- Stage 1 delivered via outside training source
- Stage 2 through 7 Training delivered at field facilities using emerging technologies
- Stage 6 RTF must return to Academy
- Curriculum Architecture and outcomes based training as foundation of curriculum development

Post-Certification Technical Training

- Recurrent is developed based off of safety data
- Advanced training is centralized at the FAA Academy and can be delivered across all domains concurrently

- Navigation
- Communication
- Surveillance
- Automation
- Environmental

Technical Training for Certification

- Correspondence course
- Classroom
- Labs
- Web-based
- Out of agency
- On-the-Job Training

Post-Certification Technical Training

- Only delivered when the certification on the sub-system or service has changed

NextGen equipment

- No standardization of training developed by the Program Office(s)

Disciplines

- Cross-discipline training

Technical Training for Certification

- Common Principles Job jeopardy
- Use modern technology to determine training/certification criteria
- Curriculum Architecture and outcomes based training as foundation of curriculum development

Post-Certification Technical Training

- Only delivered when the certification on the system has changed
- T-SAP training
- Identify and develop refresher training
