



## **EDMS 5.1.2 Release Notes**

EDMS is a combined emissions and dispersion model for assessing air quality at civilian airports and military air bases. The model was developed by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in cooperation with the United States Air Force (USAF).

EDMS was updated to version 5.1.2 to correct two problems associated with the VALE Emission Reduction Reports.

- The incorrect title “AERC Report” is displayed instead of “Emission Reduction Report for Cost Effectiveness” or “Emission Reduction Report for AERCs” when using EDMS 5.1.1 which was updated from an earlier version of EDMS via the “5.0.x-5.1.1” update executable from the FAA’s EDMS website.
- The “Cumulative Total” of the report may show the incorrect number for the VALE scenario.
