
The licensee shall at all times conduct its operations in accordance with the regulations prescribed by the Office of Commercial Space Transportation for the activities authorized by this license.


LICENSE ORDER REGARDING OPERATION OF A
LAUNCH SITE

AUTHORIZED BY LICENSE NO. LSO 01-005 (Rev 1)

SPACEPORT SYSTEMS INTERNATIONAL, L.P.

1. Authority: This Order is issued to Spaceport Systems International, L.P. (referred to as SSI) under 51 U.S.C. Subtitle V, Ch. 509, and 14 C.F.R. Ch. III.
 2. Purpose: This Order modifies License No. LSO 01-005 (Rev 1) issued September 12, 2011, by the Federal Aviation Administration's Office of Commercial Space Transportation (FAA/AST), authorizing SSI to operate California Spaceport (CSP) as a launch site at Vandenberg Air Force Base (VAFB), and prescribes as conditions to License No. LSO 01-005 (Rev 1) certain additional requirements applicable to the authorization to operate a launch site at CSP.
 3. Authorization: SSI is authorized to operate a launch site at CSP:
 - (a) For government launches and licensed launches of small payload weight class (less than or equal to 3300 lb) of orbital expendable vehicles, in accordance with 14 C.F.R. § 420.19, for launch azimuths from 168 through 220 degrees, inclusive; and
 - (b) As required by § 420.51, in accordance with the representations in SSI's application A-01-SSI-099, and any subsequent amendments approved by AST as of the date of this Order, and any modifications to the license issued by the FAA under 14 C.F.R. § 420.47.
 4. License Term: The term of License No. LSO 01-005 (Rev 1) authorizing SSI to operate a launch site at VAFB is five (5) years from the effective date of License Order No. LSO 01-005A (Rev 1).
