

1. Authority: This Order is issued to Alaska Aerospace Corporation (referred to as AAC or the licensee) under 51 U.S.C. Subtitle V, Chapter 509, and 14 C.F.R. Ch. III.
 2. Purpose: This Order modifies License No. LSO 03-008 (Rev 3) issued on April 13, 2015, authorizing AAC to operate a launch site at Pacific Spaceport Complex Alaska (PSCA) on Kodiak Island, Alaska. It also prescribes conditions to License No. LSO 03-008.
 3. Authorization: AAC is authorized to operate a launch site at Pacific Spaceport Complex Alaska:
 - (a) for U.S. Government or FAA-licensed or permitted launches; and
 - (b) as required by 14 C.F.R. § 420.51, in accordance with the representations in AAC's license application, and any subsequent amendments approved by AST as of the date of this Order, and any modifications to the license issued by the FAA under 14 C.F.R. § 420.47.
 4. Public Safety Responsibility: AAC is responsible for ensuring the safe operation of PSCA and for ensuring that public safety and safety of property are protected at all times during its licensed activities.
 5. Equivalent Level of Safety: AAC is authorized to use the Department of Defense standards for earth covered magazines, specifically Department of Defense standard 6055.9, C5.2.1.1 and C9.4.1.5, for the earth covered magazines at the rocket motor storage facility described in its submission dated August 24, 2009.

6. License Term: The term of License No. LSO 03-008 authorizing AAC to operate a launch site at PSCA is five (5) years from September 24, 2018.
