LICENSE ORDER REGARDING OPERATION OF A REENTRY SITE

AUTHORIZED BY LICENSE NO. RSO 22-001

- 1. <u>Authority</u>: This Order is issued to Huntsville-Madison County Airport Authority (HMCAA) under 51 U.S.C. Subtitle V, chapter 509, and 14 C.F.R. Ch. III.
- 2. Purpose: This Order grants License No. RSO 22-001, issued on May 13, 2022, by the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) Office of Commercial Space Transportation (AST), authorizing HMCAA to operate certain portions of Huntsville International Airport (HSV) as a reentry site at Huntsville, Alabama and prescribes, as conditions to License No. RSO 22-001, certain additional requirements applicable to the authorization.
- 3. <u>Authorization</u>: HMCAA is authorized to operate a reentry site at HSV:
 - (a) For FAA-authorized reentries; and
 - (b) As required by 14 C.F.R. § 433.3(b), in accordance with the representations in HMCAA's license application, and any subsequent amendments approved by AST as of the date of this Order, and any modifications to the license issued by the FAA;
- 4. <u>Vehicle Types</u>: RSO 22-001 authorizes HMCAA to offer its reentry site to a reentry vehicle operator for the type and weight class of reentry vehicle identified in the license application and upon which the licensing determination is based.
- 5. Other Obligations: Issuance of a license to operate a reentry site does not relieve a licensee of its obligation

to comply with any other laws or regulations; nor does it confer any proprietary, property, or exclusive right in the use of airspace or outer space.

- 6. <u>U.S. Coast Guard Agreement</u>: At least 60 days prior to any licensed reentry operation to the Huntsville Reentry Site, HMCAA must provide FAA an agreement with the local U.S. Coast Guard district to establish procedures for the issuance of a Notice to Mariners prior to a reentry and other such measures as the Coast Guard deems necessary to protect public health and safety. This agreement must be maintained for the duration of the license.
- 7. <u>License Term</u>: The term of License No. RSO 22-001 authorizing HMCAA to operate a reentry site at HSV is five (5) years from May 13, 2022, the date of issuance, unless surrendered, suspended, or revoked before the expiration of the term and is renewable upon application by the licensee.
- 8. Transfer of License: Only the FAA may transfer a license to operate a reentry site. The FAA will transfer a license to an applicant who has submitted an application in accordance with 14 C.F.R. part 413, satisfied the requirements of 14 C.F.R. part 433, and obtained approval required by § 433.3(a) for a license. The FAA may incorporate by reference any findings made part of the record that supported a prior related licensing determination.
- 9. Modifications: Upon application or upon its own initiative, the FAA may modify License No. RSO 22-001 at any time by issuing a license order that adds, removes, or modifies a license term or condition to ensure compliance with 51 U.S.C. Subtitle V Chapter 509 and the requirements of 14 C.F.R. Chapter III.
 - (a) HMCAA shall apply to the FAA for modification of License No. RSO 22-001 if it proposes to operate the reentry site in a manner that is not authorized by this license or if it proposes to operate the reentry site in a manner that would make any representation contained in the license application that is material to public health and safety or safety of property no longer accurate and complete.

- (b) An application to modify this license shall be prepared and submitted in accordance with 14 C.F.R. part 413. HMCAA shall indicate any part of its license or license application that would be changed or affected by a proposed modification.
- 10. Compliance Monitoring: HMCAA shall allow access by and cooperate with federal officers or employees or other individuals authorized by the FAA to observe any activities of the licensee, its customers, its contractors, or subcontractors, associated with licensed operation of the licensee's reentry site.
