General. The licensee is authorized to conduct launches of Zenit-3SL launch vehicles, on launch azimuths and transporting classes of payloads to orbital destinations as identified in license orders issued by the Federal Aviation Administration. The launch is authorized to take place from the Pacific Ocean at 0° Latitude and 154° West Longitude.

This license is granted subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations set forth in licensing orders A (Rev 4) and B (Rev 3), and any subsequent orders issued by the Office of Commercial Space Transportation.


The licensee shall at all times conduct its operations in accordance with the regulations prescribed by the Office of Commercial Space Transportation for the activities authorized by this license.

1. Authority: This Order is issued to S7 Sea Launch Limited (referred to as S7SL) under 51 U.S.C. Subtitle V, chapter 509, and 14 C.F.R. Ch. III.
2. Purpose: This Order modifies License No. LLO 02-066 (the license) originally issued to Sea Launch Limited Partnership on August 2, 2002, by the Federal Aviation Administration's Office of Commercial Space Transportation (FAA), authorizing S7SL to conduct launches; and prescribes as conditions to the license requirements applicable to those launches.
3. Definitions: For purposes of the license and any orders issued by the FAA pertaining to activities covered by the license, the term "launch" shall mean flight of a Zenit-3SL launch vehicle commencing upon first stage ignition. A nominal flight ends upon S7SL's last exercise of control over the Zenit-3SL launch vehicle, including the safing of Zenit-3SL launch vehicle stages or components that reach Earth orbit, following separation of the payload.
4. Authorization: S7SL is authorized to conduct the launch of a launch vehicle:
 - (a) Using a Zenit-3SL launch vehicle;
 - (b) From the Pacific Ocean at 0° Latitude and 154° West Longitude;
 - (c) On any launch azimuth from 82.6° to 97.4°, inclusive;
 - (d) Transporting telecommunications, remote sensing, observation, navigation, and scientific satellites to geosynchronous transfer orbit, as described in the application; and
 - (e) Subject to the description of the launch vehicle,

launch vehicle systems, and safety management program represented in the application as of the date of this Order, and subject to the terms of any amendments to the license application that the FAA approves in writing.

5. Reporting Requirements: S7SL shall provide a written environmental monitoring report to the FAA, in accordance with the Sea Launch Environmental Monitoring and Protection Plan, no later than sixty (60) days following each launch conducted under the license.
6. License Term: The term of the license authorizing S7SL to conduct launches is five (5) years from June 21, 2016.

1. Authority: This Order is issued to S7 Sea Launch Limited (referred to as S7SL or the licensee) under 51 U.S.C. Subtitle V, chapter 509, and 14 C.F.R. Ch. III.
 2. Purpose: This Order modifies License No. LLO 02-066 (the license) by prescribing financial responsibility requirements for licensed launch activities in accordance with 14 C.F.R. part 440.
 3. Definitions: For purposes of this Order, "licensed launch activities" shall mean activities authorized by the license. Other terms used in this Order are defined in accordance with 14 C.F.R. § 440.3.
 4. Liability Insurance: S7SL shall maintain a policy or policies of liability insurance (or otherwise demonstrate financial responsibility) in accordance with 14 C.F.R. § 440.9(b) in the amount of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) for covered claims resulting from licensed launch activities.
 5. Government Property Insurance: The FAA will not require S7SL to obtain U.S. Government property insurance under 14 C.F.R. § 440.9(d).
