

1. Authority: This Order is issued to Space Florida, under 51 U.S.C. Subtitle V, chapter 509, and 14 C.F.R. Ch. III.
  2. Purpose: This Order modifies License No. LSO 18-018, issued on November 8, 2018, by the Federal Aviation Administration's Office of Commercial Space Transportation (FAA/AST), authorizing Space Florida to operate the Cape Canaveral Spaceport as a launch site at the Shuttle Landing Facility (SLF) on the Kennedy Space Center and prescribes, as conditions to License No. LSO 18-018, certain additional requirements applicable to the authorization.
  3. Authorization: Space Florida is authorized to operate Cape Canaveral Spaceport as a launch site at the SLF:
    - (a) for FAA-licensed or permitted launches (see note below); and
    - (b) as required by 14 C.F.R. § 420.51, in accordance with the representations in Space Florida's license application, any subsequent amendments approved by the FAA as of the date of this Order, and any modifications to the license issued by the FAA under 14 C.F.R. § 420.47.

4. License Term: The term of License No. LSO 18-018 authorizing Space Florida to operate a launch site at the SLF is five (5) years from November 8, 2018, the effective date of its license.
