Purpose: This Order modifies License No. LSO 10-014 (Rev 1) issued concurrently by the Federal Aviation Administration's Office of Commercial Space Transportation (FAA/AST), authorizing SPFL to operate a launch site at Launch Complex 46 (LC-46) on Cape Canaveral Air Force Station, Florida, and prescribes as conditions to License No. LSO 10-014 (Rev 1) certain additional requirements applicable to the authorization to operate a launch site at LC-46.
- 3. <u>Authorization</u>: SPFL is authorized to operate a launch site at LC-46 for U.S. Government launches and FAA licensed launches. The launch site boundaries are defined by the public access fence line shown in black in SPFL's Explosive Site Plan dated November 27, 2007.
- 5. <u>License Term</u>: The term of License No. LSO 10-014 (Rev 1) authorizing SPFL to operate a launch site at LC-46 is five (5) years from July 1, 2020.
