DUE TO THE INABILITY TO APPLY CDR'S FOR THE ORD DEPARTURES AND CONVECTIVE IMPACTS ON THE DEPARTURE TRACKS AND TO ENSURE CHICAGO ADJACENT/ALTERNATE ARTCCS RECEIVE NECESSARY FLIGHT PLANS, USERS DEPARTING FROM KZAU AIRSPACE MUST FILE AS FOLLOWS: (1) FILE TO THE FOLLOWING NADIN ADDRESSEES: (A) FLIGHTS FROM KZAU TO/THROUGH KZMP SEND FLIGHT PLAN TO KZMPZQZX AND KZKCZQZX (B) FLIGHTS FROM KZAU TO/THROUGH KZID SEND FLIGHT PLAN TO KZIDZQZX, KZOBZQZX AND KZKCZQZX (C) FLIGHTS FROM KZAU TO/THROUGH KZKC SEND FLIGHT PLAN TO KZKCZQZX, KZMPZQZX AND KZIDZQZX (D) FLIGHTS FROM KZAU TO/THROUGH KZOB SEND FLIGHT PLAN TO KZOBZQZX AND KZIDZQZX (2) WHEN FILING AN ICAO FORMAT FLIGHT PLAN (FPL): INCLUDE AN EET/ ENTRY IN FIELD 18 OF THE FLIGHT PLAN FOR THE FIRST CENTER ENTERED AFTER KZAU (E.G. KZOB0013) 1410021530-1410132359 END PART 1 OF 2

!FDC 4/2637 (KZAU A0013/14) ZAU PART 2 OF 2 IL..SPECIAL (3) IF THE OPTIONAL FIELD 03B (MESSAGE NUMBER) IS POPULATED, IT MUST CONTAIN THE ARTCC LISTED ABOVE IN THE "TO" PORTION OF THE MESSAGE NUMBER (AND NOT KZAU). FOR EXAMPLE, FOR A FLIGHT EXITING KZAU TO KZMP THE FIELD 03B SHOULD CONTAIN NNN/KZMP123 WHERE NNN IS THE SENDERS NADIN ADDRESS AND 123 IS THE MESSAGE NUMBER. FLIGHT PLANS THAT DO NOT ADHERE TO THE ABOVE THREE ITEMS MAY NOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE COMPUTER AND THEREFORE MAY REQUIRE ADDITIONAL MANUAL HANDLING. 1410021530-1410132359 END PART 2 OF 2

- **May receive rejects from the adjacent centers that are filed with, continue to follow NOTAM guidance as this is expected**
- **For flight plans remaining within ZAU airspace file as normal with ZAU address**
- **Ryan Westbrook (Seattle)- ZSE reroutes for Vancouver need to be sure to file the VOR**
