SUMMARY

This paper presents information on the Pacific Seamless Airspace Chart.

1 Introduction

1.1. The Pacific Seamless Airspace Chart was first created by the member states of Informal South Pacific ATC Coordinating Group (ISPACG). The chart is an excel spreadsheet that lists the Air Navigation Service Providers (ANSP) and the Flight Information Regions (FIR).

2 Discussion

2.1. The seamless airspace chart provides information on separation standards, communication capabilities, surveillance and also Air Traffic Service Interfacility Data Administration Communication (AIDC).

2.2. The seamless airspace chart is a reference document to allow individuals and ANSPs information for existing capabilities but also more importantly future capabilities.
