SUMMARY

This paper presents information on the recent changes to the Russian AIP regarding filing of alternative entry/exit points in R-forms. .

1 Introduction

1.1. At several previous CPWG meetings, United Airlines proposed that the Russian Federation consider a change that would list the requested “unpaired” entry and exit fixes for a particular flight to reduce the complexity of the R Form process.

2 Discussion

2.1 After running all necessary system checks and validations, Federal Air Transport Agency of Russia issued NOTAM A1360/15 with the effective date of May 28, 2015 allowing to list “unpaired” all possible alternative entry/exit points into/from the Russian airspace in R-forms. A copy of NOTAM A1360/15 is in the Attachment A.

3 Recommendation

3.1. The Meeting is invited to note the information provided in this paper.

3.2. The above simplification of R-form will provide greater flexibility in selection of routes in the Russian airspace.

3.3. The airlines concerned are kindly requested to take the above NOTAM into consideration when preparing new R-forms after May 28, 2015.

E)CHANGES INCORPORATED IN AIP RUSSIA BOOK 1 SECTION GEN 1.2,
PARAGRAPH 2.5 AS FLW:

POSITION 15 SHALL INDICATE ALL PLANNED ALTERNATE POINTS OF ENTRY INTO THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION AIRSPACE AND THEN ALL PLANNED ALTERNATE POINTS OF EXIT FROM THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION AIRSPACE SEPARATED BY COMMAS. INDICATED ALTERNATE POINTS MUST CORRESPOND TO GEOGRAPHICAL DIRECTION OF THE FLIGHT AND BELONG TO THE ROUTE/ROUTES, THE USE OF WHICH IS GRANTED TO THE AIRLINE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF VALID BILATERAL INTERGOVERNMENTAL AND INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS ON THE ISSUE OF AIR TRAFFIC BETWEEN THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION AND THE FOREIGN STATE.)
