ANCHORAGE TERMINAL RADAR APPROACH CONTROL LETTER TO AIRMEN NO. 07-02

SUBJECT: VFR Aircraft Conducting Practice Instrument Approaches

CANCELLATION: December 1, 2009

VFR aircraft conducting practice instrument approaches at Anchorage International Airport, Merrill Field Airport and Elmendorf Air Force Base will be provided IFR separation effective at the time the approach clearance is issued. ATC will provide:

- Standard lateral and longitudinal IFR separation between IFR aircraft and VFR aircraft conducting practice instrument approaches.
- Except when operating beneath heavy or B757 aircraft, 500 feet vertical separation may be applied between VFR aircraft and between a VFR and an IFR aircraft.

Aircraft requesting practice instrument approaches should contact Anchorage Approach Control on 119.1/363.2 or 118.6/290.5 when approaching from the north and 126.4 or 123.8/257.9 when approaching from the south.
