SUBJECT: Valdez Temporary Flight Service Station

CANCELLATION: May 10, 2009

The Alaska Flight Service Information Area Group (AFSIAG) will be operating a Temporary Flight Service Station during the 2009 Valdez May Day Fly-In and Airshow. On-site specialists from Ketchikan and Kotzebue Flight Service Stations, and Kenai Automated Flight Service Station will provide over-the-counter and mass pilot briefings as well as handle over-the-counter flight plan actions. Additionally, Airport Advisories will be provided on the Common Traffic Advisory Frequency (CTAF) 122.9. For Airport Advisories, pilots are requested to monitor the current AWOS, frequency 118.8, and then report their position and intentions to "Valdez Radio" on initial call-up. The Valdez Remote Communications Outlet, frequency 122.2, will continue to be monitored by the Juneau AFSS and should be used for obtaining weather information or any additional airborne services.

Pilot weather briefings and services will be available in the Alpine Aviation office on the main floor in the terminal building at Pioneer Field.

Hours of operation for the Valdez Temporary Flight Service Station will be:

May 8, 2009 ----- noon to 7:00 p.m.
May 9, 2009 ----- 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
May 10, 2009 ----- 7:00 a.m. to noon.



1. Airport Advisories - Contact Valdez Temporary Flight Service 122.9
2. During Flour Bombing/STOL events:
 - a. Participants-Fly inner traffic pattern (see diagram above)
 - b. Participants-Use Airshow frequency. 122.8 for traffic pattern and 125.0 for taxiing.
 - c. All Aircraft-Use 125.0 for taxi. Contact Temporary FSS when ready at runway.
3. Pioneer Field itinerant and touch & go traffic use outer traffic pattern (see diagram)
