**SUBJECT:** FAA Coordination of Pending SIAPs

**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:** FAA policy is to provide 14 CFR Part 97 coordination of original and amended SIAPs to ALPA only for airports that the FAA determines are served by air carrier service. ALPA recently requested that FAA Order 8260.19, "Flight procedures and Airspace" be amended to provide ALPA with all Part 97 coordinations. The FAA rejected our request stating that they kept good track of airports with air carrier operations.

**RECOMMENDATION:** AFS-420 be directed to change policy direction to AVN-100, so that ALPA receives all Part 97 rulemaking coordinations.

**COMMENTS:** This affects FAA Order 8260.19, "Flight procedures and Airspace".

**INITIAL DISCUSSION (Meeting 99-02):** Wally Roberts presented this issue on behalf of ALPA, who is requesting policy that they be included in the coordination process for **all** Part 97 procedures. They believe they have a valid need for this coordination to support their commuter airline members. This request was originally made during formal coordination of Change 2 to Order 8260.19 earlier this year. At that time the request was denied on AVN-100's request based on the rationale that they provide ALPA coordination copies of all SIAP's at Part 139 airports. Brad Rush, AVN-110, stated that AVN-100 has reconsidered the ALPA position and it appears there will be no problem in accommodating the request. Once agreement is reached, AFS-420 will make the required change to Order 8260.19. AFS-420 and AVN-110 agreed to take the issue under advisement and report at the next meeting.

**Action:** AFS-420 & AVN-110.

**MEETING 00-01:** Brad Rush, AVN-160, coordinated ALPA's request to receive all Part 97 SIAP's for review. AVN-100 has agreed to the request and is currently forwarding these SIAP's to ALPA. Order 8260.19, paragraph 837d, will reflect this policy in Change 3. Brad also briefed the status of AVN-100's web site. It is planned that coordination copies of all SIAP forms, to include 'stick drawings', will be available to the public via this site. The target date for the web site completion is FY 4/00. Brad recommend closure and the group agreed. **Issue Closed.**
