

PARC Telecon Summary

June 8, 2005

1. **Mike to coordinate 8260.RNPSAAAR comments** dispositions ASAP.
Mike noted that the notice of rejections had been sent out to their originators. The order was signed out Friday, but a number has not been assigned. It will be posted as soon as a numbered version is received. Outstanding comments i.e. those rejected can be put back into PARC for discussion as issue papers. This is up to the originators to take those actions.
ACTION ITEM: Bruce – took the action to post the order on the site.
2. **Review of AC90-RNPSAAAR comments – DeCleene**
Dave Nakamura pointed out that the AC is the critical piece in the material needed to implement public RNP SAAAR, that the level of priority and focus appears less than for the order, and the priority needs to be raised. Focals like Mike and Jack Corman were for the order are needed. Bruce agreed and pointed out that the 303 comments had just been compiled in a matrix, following the practice from the work on the order. While closer examination is needed, the key areas are 10-7 and inhibiting DME. Both are subject to action teams and the timing for completion is very important. For DME, if the AT is not able to get a consensus conclusion, the AC will follow the original PARC direction that in conducting RNP, there must be a procedure/process to assure that DME updating is not in effect, and discontinuing the operation if it is. The 10-7 issue is more complex and at greater risk in taking more time to arrive at a solution.
ACTION ITEM: Bruce will do a revision to reflect the DME discussion. Olga will have the language sent out to the people on Mike Cramer's AT (check), and let them comment on that text.
3. **Schedule and Program Management**
Dave saw Mark yesterday, and work is in progress. Since no comments were received on the form and structure, the current format will be used. It is expected that as more detailed work tasks are shown, PARC will be able to provide more specific issues and responses to the tasks and schedules.
ACTION ITEM: Have Mark post what's available at this time.
4. **Operational Safety Assessment – Shahidi**
The Working Group will coordinate with the ATA Task Force leadership to determine what arrangements and support is possible Hassan stated that he'd spoken briefly with Kathy, and will get 30 min. on the TF agenda to get the interested parties engaged (1st week in August). The Task Force provides access to the operations expertise that is needed for this activity. From a WG standpoint, there was a telcon last week and we're moving forward.
5. **Type A, Type B Procedures –Kathy Abbott and Bill Vaughn** will define a plan and schedule for this activity following the upcoming Task Force meeting in Minneapolis – August 2-4.

6. **RNP Charting - Pedro Rivas** is continuing with WG to refine and identify issues, participate with the appropriate groups i.e. ACF, ATA FMS Task Force, etc. Pedro indicated that there is a telcon today 1-2:30pm, and a meeting next Wed. and Thursday in Oklahoma City. He is very pleased with Participation.

7. **Human Factors WG** – Kathy Abbott
The WG will have a telcon tomorrow – 1-3pm.

8. **ATL RNAV** –
Tom Sorrell reported that there are still a small number of problems, mainly to do with pilots not selecting the correct runways. Part of the interim solution is to take off on initial vectors then get cleared to the SID. There is a big issue with human performance, procedures, training, interfaces, etc in this activity that are critical for RNP operations. There was general agreement that PARC and specifically the Human Factors WG need to weigh in on the human performance, training, policy, etc issues.
ACTION ITEM: get this tied into Kathy’s group.
ACTION ITEM: GA and AOPA members are still needed to give input on the above issues. Olga will identify this issue to the PARC members to enlist their help in this area. Wally Roberts has volunteered to participate in these discussions.

9. **RNAV/SAAAR Comparison – Sorrell/Webb**
Tom noted that he had submitted a paper to Dave/PARC on this issue. He emphasized that a large portion of the RNP fleet that cannot participate in RNP SAAAR. Non-VNAV capability is also a significant issue. This has been discussed with John M. and Jeff W. and once RNP SAAAR Notice comes out, this can be readdressed.
Item on hold – waiting on John McGraw’s comment.

10. **DA in a turn Issue**

ACTION ITEM: Ted hasn’t received any comments on ToRs. He will put out the ToRs – stand by for the assignments by next telcon.

11. **Future Meetings** – Survey – No responses received on the November meeting.
Telcons – next call is two weeks from now.
Wally pointed out that with the current dates we have for November John and Jeff will be at NBAA convention in New Orleans. PARC might need to consider a different venue or reschedule the meeting.
