

PARC Telecon Summary July 6, 2005

Past Action Items (Click on “Action Items” on the right-hand side)

- **DA in a Turn** – Demosthenes

- **TARGETs Capability**, PARC Comments on posted recommendation, Follow up resolution, Chair letter one week after finalized
John McGraw stated that the FAA will have a configuration review board this August and then we’ll review this issue and address it appropriately. They might add the new functionality to TARGETS, RNAV pro, or may have a new tool depending on the board’s discussion.

Status & Issues

- **AC90 RNP SAAAR** Status and Schedule - FAA

Comment resolution status, next steps and schedule

John McGraw mentioned that comments have been resolved, table is completed – 10-7 and DME/DME sensor agnostics are the two remaining issues. Sensor agnostics AT has been working their issue.

10-7 has been addressed at the meeting with Continental and Boeing in Houston. FAA will schedule a follow-up meeting next week. FAA will get back to the PARC at the next telcon.

- **Database LOA Implementation Progress** – FAA

Vendor approval status and schedule

John McGraw noted that AC 20 DB is expected to be signed this week.

Action Item: Bruce DeCleene will find out how long it will take to get the approvals.

- **8260.RNPSAAAR** Implementation Status – FAA

8260.52 has been posted on the PARC main site and an e-mail notice has been sent out to everyone on the PARC.

Wally Roberts noted that there needs to be an implementation policy guidance. FAA does not have that in place at this time, maybe by the F2F.

- **RNP Program and Activities Schedule**

Succession plan for Mark Fuhrman. This is a prime work discussion item for the F2F.

Jeff – Implementation plan is going to be included in this schedule.

- FAA mentioned that by the end of November all of **RNAV criteria** will be drafted and out for PARC's comment.

Status for resolution of Rockwell Collins issue
