

PARC Telecon Summary  
August 17, 2005

**Action Items from the PARC F2F:**

1. **AC90-RNPSAAAR** – Vinnie Chirasello/Bruce DeCleene  
**Action Item:** Resolution of final DME/DME issue and Status of AC  
Bruce stated that it's in final coordination, on target for the end of September completion date. Statements that initially procedure is not based on DME/DME have been replaced by new text, which starting a procedure based on GPS, and after that depends on the aircraft and the particular approach. Concerns were raised about current applications.  
**Action Item:** Bruce and Vinnie will send the language to Bill Vaughn.
  
2. **Critical Schedule and Program Review**  
**Action Item:** Address the Type A/B and revisiting 90-100 – Frank Alexander.  
**Preliminary report from the AC 90-100 action team** – Frank Alexander  
Bruce DeCleene pointed out that the AC 90-100 implementation date for September is fast approaching, that the FAA has received just two vendor assessments. It is urgent that industry responses be provided now. Regarding the action team, Bill Vaughn mentioned that there is an Action Team F2F meeting at ATA next Tuesday.
  
3. **Communications Working Group Roadmap** – Tom Kraft/Ann Tedford  
Tom mentioned their flight plan issue paper was passed on to an existing Flight Plan Suffix Action Team, although this action team has been quiet for some time and will need to include participation from the CWG.  
Tann commented that the **Flight Plan Suffix AT** needs to give their plan on addressing the white paper that Tom Kraft presented (pg 7 and 12 of the minutes). **Vinnie is the co-chair**. With what is going on in Aug/Sep, he may not be able to get to this until after Oct 1 or so.  
  
Bruce stated that it's an important activity. He raised a question of who's going to be the chair on the industry side. He also emphasized that this activity has to be harmonized with the ICAO Flight Plan (Rich Gehlen is the chair) Study Group – this is where the Flight Plan Suffix issue might have to go.  
The chair of **Flight Plan Suffix AT**, Ellis Thorp, has been not involved with PARC recently  
**Action Item:** Olga will issue an e-mail to request interested parties' participation in this group.

**Action Item:** Impending Deadline - Tom Kraft sent out Roadmap for Data link out for comment. Due date for comment is **September 2<sup>nd</sup>**. Comment form is included. Send comments to Tom Kraft and Ann Tedford.

Bruce reiterated that PARC would have one last chance to take a look at it by Sep. 19<sup>th</sup> – and the schedule is very critical.

**Final PARC discussion on the Roadmap – include on one of the PARC telcons between the 19<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>.**

**4. DA In a Turn** – Ted Demosthenes

**Action Item:** Ted Demosthenes is to give his plan for forming the DAWG. This action item has been put on hold due to Ted’s absence from the telcon.

**5. Critical Decisions Working Group - Davis**

**Action Item:** Jerry Davis to provide draft recommendations letter.

Jerry will have it by COB Thursday, August 18.

Jerry said that the WG had a very productive meeting in Minneapolis the week before last.

**Other Action Items:**

**1. Database LOA Implementation Progress** – Bruce DeCleene (FAA)

Vendor Approval status and schedule

Bruce stated that both Honeywell (type 2) and Jeppesen (type 1) have their LOAs. On the European side they’ve issued LOAs to all the type 1 (data) suppliers. All other vendors are aware of this and are in charge of their own LOAs. The FAA is encouraging them to apply by the end of September.

**2. 8260.52 (RNPSAAAR) Implementation Status** – FAA

Wally pointed out that the order must be accompanied by the detailed information and instruction necessary for the procedure designer to use the criteria in procedure design. Documentation is being developed (AVN-100 and AFS-420 are working on it). DCA is going to be the first site. 8260.52 will roll over into TERPS and it’s currently in process. AC 90 RNP is also in dependency to this.

**Action Item:** FAA will follow up on this item with John McGraw when he returns. Make sure to place it in the implementation plan and PARC Schedule (Tann Pinney).
