Agreement has been reached to hold the meeting on June 27-28 in OKC, and the participants have been finalized. No consensus has been reached on previous recommendations, such as descent angles. This will provide a means to have a large part of the small systems market involved. The exact meeting location in OKC is TBD. 10. N8000.300 and Update to AC120-29A McGraw

Mark Steinbicker stated that discussion have been taking place within the FAA. However, it has not yet been decided what guidance from 8000.300 to keep. Individuals within the FAA took a look at the document and were unsure what to keep, and are looking for input from the PARC as to what they feel should be kept. An Action Team to work the issue was discussed because of the urgency resulting from the imminent expiration of the Order. It was suggested to perhaps renew the Order for another year to give ourselves more time and “do the job right”. It was noted that we have a much clear picture today of RNP implementation and the different segments of the population and their needs. A change to 29A isn’t a solution for everyone and now may only be required for advanced aircraft or the air transport category. Others will be served through AC90-101 and the new AC90-RNP. It was agreed that the whole PARC should be aware of the issue and solicited for their input. The objective for the working group will be to establish what specific form and

criteria is needed to augment the guidance that exists in 29A today. The working group isn't expected to write the material. It should provide sufficient details to enable the development of the AC material as well as being available to aid the work..
