

PARC Telecon Summary

February 28, 2007

1. Critical Decisions Working Group

Davis

The briefing distributed by Jerry Davis on the 13th outlined the four remaining recommendations with suggestions as to what should be done with them. The priority of the remaining recommendations was discussed. Jerry Davis has assigned no priorities but feels the first one is important. Ted Demosthenes stated that the 4th is of a high importance as well. As for the first recommendation, it is not clear if it should be a PARC activity or some other advisory group. RTCA is addressing some issues now and should be made aware that the PARC is also looking at these issues. The PARC needs to make it clear what work will be done by the PARC and what will be done by other groups. The recommendation is to go forward with the proposal outlined in the brief from Jerry..

3. AC90-101 and 8260.52

Cramer

At the AT meeting of Feb. 15th the group was able to work through 26 out of 108 update suggestions to 8260.52. AC 90-101 was not worked. 7 out of the 26 actions worked were assigned to individuals for further work. Mike Cramer made a request for Air Traffic participation in the AT. They will be holding their first telecon this Friday to work the AC. The decision has been made to use smaller groups within the main AT to focus on certain items in detail. A Summary of the meeting will be sent by Mike Cramer to Steve Albers to post to the KSN site, and Steve will create a subweb for the AT on the KSN site.
