

PARC Telecon Summary

March 28, 2007

1. Critical Decisions Working Group Transition TBD

John Swigart took an Action to contact Frank Alexander requesting his assistance in drafting the ToRs for the new Working Group that will work the remaining CDWG recommendations.

2. RPAT Porter

Don Porter was unable to participate in the telecon. He will be contacted for an update by the next telecon, scheduled for Thursday, April 11th.

3. AC90-101 and 8260.52 Cramer

An updated Issue Matrix has been posted to the groups KSN site. Future telecons will begin to address operator issues. The issues initially raised by Roger Burns are drawing to a close – they have not been resolved, but actions have been assigned to team members to continue working them. Dave Nakamura requested that Steve Fulton stay involved in this activity.

4. Benefits Interaction AT Cramer

Dave Nakamura will be forwarding the approved letter to Nick Sabatini.

5. Nav Data Switchover Carman

Pedro Rivas believes that many of the issues have been resolved, but some need to be brought forward to the full PARC for discussion. Pedro will be contacting AFS-420 for their input, and Jim Carman will draft a paper to forward to the PARC for review on the rollover time.

6. Migration of Non-public Elements of Notice 8000.300 Fulton

The concerns raised at the last telecon have been resolved. Larry Schwartzkopf. has been cleared to co-chair the group. Steve Fulton met with Mike Cramer to discuss possible overlap of activities and resolved any conflicts. A list of items that could require migration to another location will be brought to the group for discussion. A schedule for completion of activities asked for by Dave Nakamura for the next telecon.

7. Open Action Item Review Swigart

Action Items reviewed. Wally Roberts has submitted the NBAA Airspace Recommendation Paper to complete Action Item 1.19.07-06. Steve Albers will upload the

Paper to the PARC Members KSN library and distribute it to the PARC for review and comment.

8. New Business

An issue was raised regarding whether or not Industry was getting enough information and education as to what was being done for RNP implementation. It was suggested that the FAA develop some sort of program or plan to better educate people about all the work that was going on for RNP. It was also suggested that this was an issue that the PARC as a whole should consider.

Bruce DeCleene indicated that some manufacturers have asked if the database process acceptance used for navigation databases can be extended to cover terrain and obstacle data. The policy for navigation databases (AC 20-153, RTCA/DO-200A) ensures that the process for managing data, as it moves from company to company and is ultimately loaded in the aircraft, retains the quality of the source data. For terrain and obstacle data (used in TAWS), the terrain database is included within the design of some systems which makes updating the database difficult.

Based on the success that we have had with navigation database LOAs, should the same policy be extended so it can be applied to terrain and obstacle data? As the original navigation database guidance was developed through a PARC working group, Bruce requested that PARC members provide feedback on whether or not they would support expanding the LOA policy to cover terrain and obstacle data

A new day for the telecons is required. Future telecons will take place on Thursdays from 11:00 – 12:00, with the next one scheduled for April 12th.
