

PARC Telecon Summary

April 26, 2007

1. Critical Decisions Implementation Action Team Alexander

Draft TORs for the new AT have been submitted by Frank Alexander. A deadline of May 3rd was given for comments on the ToRs. Steve Albers will send out a message to the PARC regarding the comment deadline.

2. AC90-101 and 8260.52 Cramer

The last group telecon was held on the 20th, and dealt with approximately seven more issues in the AC. Mike Cramer sent out an email to the group requesting they review and provide feedback on the issues discussed. A telecon with Jack Corman also took place to discuss 8260.52. The telecon planned with AFS had to be pushed back due to key staff being unable to participate. There are four or five issues remaining in 8260.52 for the group to still discuss. An additional update will be given at the F2F with more details included as to what is being discussed and what the decisions are. FAA Order 8260.54 was discussed. Dave Nakamura requested that the FAA take an Action to provide the PARC with details and the status of the Order.

3. Nav Data Switchover Carman

No update provided. The PARC is still waiting on the Issue Paper originally scheduled for completion on April 18th.

4. Migration of Non-public Elements of Notice 8000.300 Fulton

Steve Fulton met with Larry Schwartzkopf in Seattle and made progress on reconciling the list of items needing discussion. A full briefing will be given at the F2F.

5. Third Party OTA Speir

Both Jeff Williams and Ken Speir will be providing updates at the F2F.

6. Open Action Item Review Swigart

The updated Action Item list will be posted to the telecon meeting space on the PARC Members KSN site.

7. New Business

Work is progressing within the FAA on the Basic RNP Recommendations. An Approach and Landing Category meeting is being held tomorrow. Mike Webb will provide a full update on the status of the Basic RNP recommendations at the F2F.

An updated F2F Agenda will be sent out to the PARC by Steve Albers with a request for the PARC to review it for any critical discussions that may need to have their time slot bumped up to ensure proper participation in the discussion.

The RPAT letter to Nick Sabatini mentioned RPAT follow on activities. Steve Albers and John Swigart will request more info from Don Porter as to what will be done and who will be doing the work.
