**1. RNP SAAAR Update Action Team** Cramer

The draft Order will be placed on the PARC Members KSN site for review, and will be discussed at the next PARC telecon. A discussion of the Order was also suggested to be placed on the Agenda for the Aug. 8-9 F2F meeting. It was suggested that Members provide comments on the Order now through required FAA channels, while the PARC will work with the FAA on high-level issues with the Order both now and after the comment period has closed.

The FAA response to the VFWG recommendations on 8260.42B has been placed on the PARC Members KSN site. A link to the document can be found under the "Recent Documents" section on the front page of the site.

Discussions have begun on restarting the Benefits Implementation Working Group activity. It will be placed on the Agenda for the August F2F meeting for discussion with the full PARC.

A question was asked about the FMS Vertical Differences information provided by Mike Cramer at the May F2F meeting, and whether or not it would lead to any PARC activity. Mike Cramer will be contacted for further information, and the PARC will discuss during future telecons whether there is any issue to be worked by the PARC.

It still needs to be determined whether or not there is a need for a Public Meeting.
