

PARC Telecon Summary

August 30, 2007

1. .42B Closeout

Hickok

This Item has been deferred until the next telecon when an update can be received on the Action Items that came out of the Aug. 8-9 PARC F2F meeting.

2. RNP SAAAR Update Action Team

Cramer

Mike Cramer has set up a meeting in DC on Sept. 6th for a subgroup to complete a draft of Appendix 5. Pedro Rivas requested any specific recommended text for Appendix 5 be sent to him. Mike Cramer will also meet with the FAA for a detailed discussion of issues already resolved by the Action Team to help keep action moving forward.

3. TBO

Nakamura

The FAA has requested PARC input on determining the path definition requirements for Trajectory Based Operations. It needs to be determined who is interested in participating in an Action Team to discuss TBO. Dave Nakamura has a team lead in mind but has not contacted them yet. Bruce DeCleene was recommended as a necessary FAA participant on the AT. Dave Nakamura will contact Bruce regarding participation in the AT. If any PARC members wish to participate, they are asked to contact Dave Nakamura.

4. Document Strategy WG

5. Basic RNP WG

Dave Nakamura explained the RF legs and Basic/Advanced RNP tasking to Roger Burns. Wally Roberts reminded the PARC of the unresolved issue of widths of secondaries that still needed to be addressed. Roger Burns will be scheduling an initial telecon in the next couple of weeks. A request was made for FAA participation in the telecons. John Swigart will respond to Roger with FAA POCs.

6. Open Action Item Review

Majauskas

The updated Action Item list will be uploaded to KSN site in the Meeting Workspace for the telecon, and will be distributed prior to the next PARC telecon on September 13th. Jeff Williams will be contacted for an update on the status of the FAA response to the PARC Airspace recommendation.

7. New Business

Perry Clausen from Southwest will be leader of the Benefits Interaction activity once it restarts. Steve Albers will contact Dave Nakamura for Perry's contact info and will add him to the PARC distribution list.

Wally Roberts raised a charting issue with the new RNP SAAAR approach developed for Bishop, CA. The Jeppesen chart is not in compliance with the source note. Pedro Rivas stated that there are a number of different charting issues arising, with the Bishop approach being one of them. He plans on an October/early November telecon to discuss charting issues. Pedro believes the Bishop, CA issue may be an error on Jeppesen's part and will be corrected shortly, and he will be contacting Jeppesen and will try to get an official reply from them regarding this. Mike Zenkovich will also contact Harry Hodges from AFS-420 to follow up on this.
