

# PARC Telecon Summary

## September 13, 2007

### 1. .42B Remaining Issues

Hickok

The issue regarding whether the development of other FAA Orders will hold up .42B is still under discussion. While Orders .42B and .54A are related, it is not believed that .54A will delay the release of .42B unless there is an RNAV criteria issue. AFS-460 will temporarily handle quality control to expedite the process of implementation of the Order until AVN completes their update for quality control automation. The issue of VGSI requirements still needs to be resolved. A meeting with the FAA was requested. Mike Webb is checking into the availability of the necessary FAA staff to participate in the discussion and will respond back to Steve Hickok. The VFWG would like a final meeting with the FAA to review all changes that have been made prior to publication.

### 2. RNP SAAAR Update Action Team

The remaining issues with the AC were worked through during the meeting held Sept. 6th. They have been captured in the Issues and Status Matrix which is available on the team's KSN site. Mike Cramer is putting together a recommendation package now for Order 8260.52, which is planned to be ready by Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>. AC 90-101 recommendations are planned to be ready by Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>.
