

# PARC Telecon Summary

## January 3, 2008

### **1. Operational Needs and Benefits of RNP AT**

**Clausen/Porter**

A summary of 12/13 F2F meeting/telecon uploaded to the KSN site. The meeting was stated to have been a success, and the target date for completion of work is by the end of January. The Action will have their next telecon on Friday, Jan. 4<sup>th</sup>.

### **2. N8000.300 Migration**

**Demosthenes**

Comments on the recommendations were due by 12/24. A draft letter to Sabatini to accompany the recommendations is being worked. NBAA comments on the recommendations were received and the recommendations will be clarified to address the comments. The letter to Sabatini is expected to be forwarded to Dave Nakamura by Wednesday of next week.

A concern was raised about the focus of the work. The activity was meant to incorporate any necessary elements from the Notice, if any, and where to place those elements. The recommendation to maintain the Notice in entirety is therefore not valid. Instead, the intent was to determine what info was no longer covered by other documents, and decide if any of it was still required. Ted Demosthenes will re-examine the data previously provided by Mike Cramer to ensure that this has been covered in the recommendations.

### **3. Vertical Flight WG**

**Hickok**

.42B was reviewed in the Dallas meeting on 12/5 with all FAA incorporated changes. The Team is on inactive status for now, and once .42B is published it will be disbanded. The AT would like a copy of the final draft for review only, and not for further comment. During the Dallas meeting, a question of grandfathering procedures was raised. The question was not covered in the AT ToRs, as the group was not meant to resolve implementation issues. New ToRs would need to be drafted to discuss implementation. One petition to reduce VFR area size was raised that FAA agreed to take a look at.

### **4. SAAAR Update Action Team**

**Cramer**

The formulation of 2 groups based on specific expertise to discuss loss of procedure availability and also multiple glide path angles was discussed. New members would need to be added to the existing SAAAR Update AT to work these issues. A request was made for John McGraw to recommend staff to assist Mike Cramer. Mike will write up a work plan for each issue to assist with the selection of the proper staff to join the Team.

A Workspace has been set up on the KSN site for the next SAAAR Update AT meeting. Steve Albers will send out a message to the PARC informing them of the meeting and a link to the Workspace so that information can be reviewed.

A reminder was given regarding the TBO ToRs. They were distributed to a small group for comment, and Mike Cramer is still waiting on comments. Once they are revised they will be sent to the main PARC.

## **5. Document Strategy WG**

**Davis**

The WG held a meeting on 11/29. A consensus was that the issue needs to be worked, and the strawman proposal was discussed. Different approaches to addressing the issue were also discussed. Minutes of the meeting are being worked, and another F2F meeting will be scheduled to coincide with the next PARC F2F. Work will be done by telecons until then.

## **6. AC 90-Use of RNAV on Conventional Routes and Procedures**

A meeting was held on 12/7 to review the new draft AC. Recommended changes from that meeting are being implemented.

## **7. OEP**

**Parra**

The OEP office plans to come out with Version 2 by June 30<sup>th</sup> with more detail than was in Version 1. There are Policy and Rulemaking ideas in Version 1 that they would like the PARC to review to see if there were any areas omitted where policy and rulemaking changes are necessary. They would also like confirmation that the priorities they have are the correct ones.

A question was raised regarding what information or documents would be given to the PARC to review, or if they would only be reviewing the previously released Version 1. Ricardo Parra took a tasking to contact Gisele Mohler and get a clarification on what the PARC will be reviewing and providing comment on.

## **8. Open Action Item Review**

**Majauskas**

An updated Action Item List has been distributed, and the PARC was reminded to review the list and respond to Steve Albers and Cathy Majauskas with any updates or changes.

## **9. New Business**

A reminder was given that comments on the Flight Deck Automation WG interim report are due by January 15<sup>th</sup>.

The Database rollover ToRs will be ready by the next telecon. Pedro Rivas will be requesting membership in the AT.

The status of .54A was requested. The response was that it was signed prior to the holidays.

The status of **AC ???** was also requested. The FAA will have to check on the AC's current status. Roger Burns asked if there was a draft his group could review, but there is no available draft at this point.

Kevin Comstock enquired about an ACF letter regarding climb gradients that had been sent to the PARC. The letter had been forwarded to Frank Alexander to be discussed by his group, but work had not yet begun on addressing the issues. A reminder will be sent to Frank regarding the tasking.
