

PARC Telecon Summary

March 27, 2008

1. RNP Concepts and Benefits AT

Clausen/Porter/Alexander

The AT is proceeding with the case studies for Las Vegas and Atlanta, and Wally Roberts has input for Santa Monica as well. The AT plans to release a report in late April. Once the report is released a decision will need to be made on future assignments for the AT. The next F2F meeting is planned for April 9th. A reminder was given that comments on the AT's initial report are due by Friday, March 28th. A reminder email has been sent to the PARC requesting comments. A group under the leadership of Frank Alexander has split off to study the need and feasibility of a Working Group to provide input to the FAA on RNP SAAAR site selection. They plan to hold a F2F meeting on the first day of the CNS Task Force meeting (8 April).

Update from the WG F2F held 18-20 Mar.

There was a wide range of participation in the March 18-20 meeting. Continental is planning to conduct flight tests in and out of Guam, but they want Boeing to provide temporary use of the FANS software. If Boeing does not provide the software, Continental may not participate in the trials. Continental also has GE engaged for FMS upgrades. The WG plans to hold their next meeting at the end of May or early June, with trials to start this summer. Assessment of the data collected from the tests will help determine the viability of the criteria. The WG would like to have AFS-200 participation for analysis of MEL release in the future.
