

PARC Telecon Summary

April 24, 2008

1. RNP Concepts and Benefits AT

Clausen/Porter/Alexander

The Action Team will be holding a telecon within the next week to discuss the comments received on Product 1. The Atlanta case study may be delayed so that the AT can focus on Las Vegas. An Atlanta case study would then be completed at a later date. It was reiterated that Frank Alexander's ad hoc group would produce a final product of a recommendation list for procedure development based on need and potential benefit.

2. Joint NECC/PARC AT

3. OEP Review AT

The Action Team planned to complete their work by the end of this week, but will not meet that deadline. They estimate they are about three weeks behind the initial goal of April 20th for completion. The AT will hold their next telecon the afternoon of the 24th.

4. AC 90-101 Navigation Data Validation

NBAA raised an issue concerning the required validation steps in Appendix 3 of the AC. They have distributed an Issue Paper, which has also been uploaded to the KSN Workspace for the telecon. Mike Cramer's group will work on this issue. According to general consensus, this may have to be a long term activity for the AT. It is also generally agreed that the guidance language could be clarified. This Action will be tracked on the PARC Action Item list.

5. RNP SAAAR Update AT

Mike Cramer contacted Mark Steinbicker and held discussions on the comments forwarded by the FAA, but further information is needed on those comments.
