

PARC Telecon Summary

June 5, 2008

1. RNP SAAAR Process

Alexander

Frank Alexander will be taking the comments he has received and developing a strawman paper to be distributed for comment. Steve Albers took an Action to contact Frank for a completion date of the strawman.

2. Communication WG

Kraft

The Working Group is looking at IRIDIUM and working on setting up flight trials with Continental. The plan will start with AOC communication. Rising fuel costs are an issue on implementing this operation and for equipage. Continental still has to put FANS on their aircraft and needs \$140k per aircraft in funding to do so. Flight trials are not planned to start until this December. It was mentioned that the CWG will need to continue coordination with the RTCA ATMAC DataCom group. A dialogue will need to take place regarding what work needs to be done and who needs to be doing it. It was noted that an RTCA public meeting is being planned. For now the DataCom work appears in line with CWG. However, how it relates to the work of SC214 is not clear. Tom Kraft took an action to provide meeting Minutes and other information to the PARC for their reference.

3. OEP Review AT

The Action Team has finished their current activity of mapping PARC near term and mid term roadmap activities to the OEP, and their findings will be gathered in a letter. It was determined that some items need further work by either the PARC or the OEP office. The OEP office thanked the PARC for their input and work. This activity is viewed as a “good start” with more work to be done in the future. The letter with findings is expected to be completed by Wednesday of next week.

Reminder – the next PARC F2F meeting has been pushed back an extra day. We are now planning to have the meeting on Thursday and Friday, July 10th -11th.

Good results were reported for RNP SAAAR procedures at Rifle, CO. Runway 8 HAT was reduced to 285' for capable aircraft, down from 1900'.

A F2F meeting is being planned for the Benefits Interaction team in Atlanta. Following the AC 90-RNP Action Team meeting at AMTI on May 13-14, a revision of the definitions for RNP Basic and Advanced was made to the Benefits Interaction AT Product 1 and circulated to the team for review. Comments were received back from GARMIN and AOPA. These comments are being coordinated with the AC 90-RNP development team at FAA and will be resolved as soon as possible.
