

PARC Telecon Summary

June 19, 2008

1. OEP Review AT

Parra

The Action Team findings have been submitted to Dave Nakamura. It was pointed out that the findings are consistent with team discussions and notes. The Team plans to brief their findings to the PARC at the July F2F meeting along with a summary of future work they recommend is needed. Ricardo Parra will be making final editorial changes to the findings letter and sending it to Dave Nakamura and Steve Albers this week.

2. Navigation Evolution Roadmap letter to Bobby Sturgell

The recommendation letter to Bobby Sturgell has been uploaded to the meeting workspace for the telecon for PARC review and comment. Steve Albers took an *Action* to contact Frank Alexander for a copy of the letter from Bobby Sturgell requesting the joint PARC/NECC review of the Roadmap. The letter will be sent out in one week.

3. RNP Benefits Action Team

A F2F meeting is planned for June 24th hosted by Delta in Atlanta. They plan to take a satellite view of the city to see what they could do with RNP for the entire metro area for departures and arrivals. They will build on what they've looked at for Vegas and prepare for a F2F update at the July PARC F2F.

AIR-130 would like more time to review the draft recommendation letter to Sabatini. AFS-470 would also like more time to review and provide comments. Steve Albers took an *Action* to discuss with AIR-130 and AFS-470 a new deadline for comments on the draft letter.

6. Open Action Item Review

Participants are requested to review the Action Item list and provide updates on their Action Items to Steve Albers.

7. New Business

PARC Members are reminded to send in their registrations for the October PARC F2F for NBAA badging/admission.

Conflicts for the July F2F were brought up by John McGraw. Internal shifting in Flight Standards (e.g. Zenkovich acting in the SW region and Smith as acting director) has resulted in minimal coverage from Flight Standards being available for the F2F. If issues need to be tabled until better coverage can be gotten, that is what will have to be done.

The draft letter from Frank Alexander for the RNP Process group that was requested will be ready by the end of next week.

A status of AC 90-RNP was requested. It was stated that the second draft has been completed, and Roger Burns will be providing comments to John Swigart. Roger noted that concerns with the first draft have been addressed in the second draft. Jerry Davis is putting final touches on the second draft and comments are being reviewed a final time to ensure everything has been addressed and it can be pointed to in the second draft where the comments were addressed. The second draft planned to be distributed for comment next week. The Basic RNP AT will be able to take a look at the second draft, and another F2F meeting will be held to discuss it.

The Perry Clausen RNP briefing that he gave to the Orange County Noise and Access Group has been uploaded to the KSN site for PARC information. It was stated that there should be a discussion at the July PARC F2F on RNP and environmental issues with the purpose to be to settle on a consistent message to provide on environmental concerns.

NBAA brought a potential issue to the PARC's attention regarding the flyability of procedures. This issue will need to be worked by Mike Cramer's group.
