

PARC Telecon Summary

December 4, 2008

1. RNP Procedure Process

Alexander

Inputs on the focus and proposed tasks of the group have been gathered and the draft ToRs should be completed by mid next week. It was mentioned that the same work that this group will be doing for RNP may need to be done as well for RNAV SIDs and STARs. Frank will contact Kathy Abbot offline to discuss this.

2. RNP SAAAR Transition to ILS

DeCleene

Progress is being made within MITRE. A draft work plan with tasks has been completed. Included in the plan is anything relative to avionics that would cause problems with or work well with an RNP curved approach to an ILS. The plan will be shared with the PARC once approval is received from Bruce DeCleene. This approval should be received by next week.

3. RNP SAAAR Update Action Team

Cramer

The Team is still focusing on Appendix 3. Two small subgroups have been split out to tackle the two big issues – data integrity insurance and flyability insurance. ToRs for those subgroups have been written, and future telecons have been scheduled. The RF bank angle and wind limitations issues are being worked by Mike Cramer, Bruce DeCleene, and Mark Steinbicker. It should be better known when closure on the two main Appendix 3 issues can be achieved after the telecons scheduled for next week have taken place. This will be briefed at the next telecon scheduled for Dec. 18th.

4. Nav Data Currency Working Group

Comstock

Since the Group held their last full telecon in October they have briefed the charting forum and held a subgroup telecon to address the P-NOTAM issue. The subgroup determined that they needed to contact legal counsel to determine if changes needed to be made to the P-NOTAM transmittal letter. This contact was made, and changes do not need to be made. The remaining question is to determine what the implementation process is for putting the date on charts, and it is unsure when that will be complete. The Action now is to make it happen, to find the FAA processes and do it. The Groups work for now is completed, with the FAA to continue and finalize work. Status and progress will be briefed at the January F2F.

5. CIAOP AT ToRs

Demosthenes

The draft ToRs will be distributed again, with a deadline for comments of Wednesday, Dec. 10th.

New Business

There has been no recent activity on TBO, the reason being that outside groups are not responding to the survey activity. Mike Cramer is unsure how to prod them for more progress. Currently the JPDO and other groups are having TBO discussions on how to get

activity going and coordinated. TBO might become an RTCA activity, with the PARC involved through them. Status will be briefed at the next telecon.

A reminder was given that the DSWG will need to become active again. Jerry Davis has been made aware of some items, but there may be others – such as advanced RNP- that his Group may need to discuss.

AC 90-RNP is planned to be out by the January F2F.

JPDO Avionics Roadmap is out and the PARC should take a look at it as it will be an influence on things we try to do in the PARC. Frank Alexander can be contacted for more information, and this will be briefed at the January F2F.

NBAA brought charting issues that are being worked with Jeppesen to the attention of the PARC.

NBAA is still waiting for a response from the FAA on the Class E airspace issue. John Dutton stated that Kelly McKee was actively working the issue and should have a response ready shortly. The plan is to conduct research first, then determine what action to take. Kelly will be contacted offline for an update during the next telecon.
