

PARC Telecon Summary

February 26, 2009

1. RNP Procedure Process

Alexander

The ToRs were reviewed by the team during the telecon held February 17th. The next telecon will be held the morning of Monday, March 2nd, with the goal being to draft a paper outlining guidance for developing recommendations to the FAA.

2. RNP Concepts and Benefits AT

Porter/Clausen

The cover letter for the two reports is almost completed. It was distributed to the team for comment and final revisions are being made. The ToR revision to reflect extended work will be done next. The ToR revision will be completed by Thursday, March 5th.

3. RNP SAAAR Transition to ILS

The survey was sent out to the OEMs Feb. 10th. A reminder email was sent out the 24th due to limited feedback received. Hawker Beech and Cessna contacts are still needed. Emails have been sent to them, but they have not yet responded. The input received from the MITRE pilots is that CAT II and III may be impossible, but that was just the initial reaction. Perry Clausen volunteered to send info on Southwest CAT II and III operations to Mike.

4. TBO Action Team

General edits need to be made to the formal letter, but it will be completed and forwarded for review by Friday, February 27.

5. ICAO flight plan transition guidance

Files have been uploaded to the telecon workspace for PARC review and information. SL 09.09 transition to new ICAO flight plan and SL 08.050 Amendment 1 to PANS.ATM should both be reviewed.

6. RNP SAAAR Update Action Team

Cramer

The team had its last Telecon on February 20th. Data integrity process subgroup is researching current and modified data flows. The team is still working on test scenarios for data faults. ARINC and the 424 subcommittee have a proposal to use CRC to wrap the entire RNP SAAAR procedure. Mike Cramer will inform the 424 subcommittee of his groups work. The flyability sub team reached agreement on the changed wording for the AC. Recommendations from both sub teams will be ready for the full group to review by the last week of March. The team will then have a F2F meeting to finalize the recommendations before presenting them to the PARC.

7. RTCA NextGen Task Force 5

Information on the Task Force was provided to the PARC. The Task Force will have an Operational Capabilities group and a Business Strategies and Investment group. No meetings have been held as of yet. The scope of their discussions will be limited to the end of mid term. The Task Force will be providing recommendations which would result in new guidance being needed from the PARC.

New Business

The Oct. F2F date has tentatively moved to Oct. 22-23 to coincide with the annual NBAA Convention in Orlando, FL.

July F2F status check. It was confirmed that this meeting will be in Seattle, hosted by Boeing.

Either Frank Alexander or Dave Nakamura will provide future updates to the PARC on the JPDO Avionics Working Group activities.

The RNP SAAAR Update AT will have a F2F meeting on April 21st. Steve Albers will check on meeting space for the team.

NBAA raised an issue concerning a NetJets special in Aspen. The procedure is being portrayed as one that is available to everyone, which could lead to unqualified operators attempting to fly it. Better guidance is needed for the FSDOs on what to do with specials, and avionics vendors and AVN need to be made aware of the issues.

An FYI was given to the PARC that on March 24th a NextGen TBO summit is planned. JPDO will be hosting the summit.

The restart of the CDWG work was again raised. Further guidance on the Groups previous recommendations and how to proceed with their implementation is needed. Dave Nakamura will have a discussion with John McGraw and others to determine how to proceed and what role Jerry Davis will have.
