

PARC Telecon Summary

June 18, 2009

1. RNP SAAAR Update Action Team

Cramer

Recommendations have been posted to the KSN site for comment, with comments due by June 26th. The RF leg analysis work is still outstanding. The team has received no response yet from the consultant regarding their status in writing up a work plan. A telecon took place last week to discuss the definition of significant change that would require a re-evaluation of RNP SAAAR procedures. Notes from the telecon will be posted to the teams KSN site. Bi-weekly telecons will take place until work is completed.

2. RNP Transition to ILS

Cramer

A comparison matrix has been constructed and populated with the inputs received so far. New information is coming in will be added to the matrix. Data has been received from everyone, but still waiting on some additional data from some. The Airbus operational review should be ready in 2-3 weeks, but avionics data has already received.

3. RNP SAAAR IAPs

Wally Roberts has been working on guidelines for kickoff meetings to work this issue. It is not believed that this can be resolved with an ad hoc group. It was agreed that this item should be added to the Agenda for discussion at the upcoming PARC F2F meeting.

4. Draft Advisory Circulars for PARC Review

Draft AC 20-138B and Draft AC 90-TPA are out for review and comment. Comments on AC 20-138B are due by June 30th and comments on AC 90-TPA are due by June 30th. Comments should be sent to Steve Albers for a single coordinated PARC response. A reminder will be sent out by email.

5. RAIM Prediction

The FAA is sticking with July 1st deadline. The concerns raised during the last telecon were about how preparations were going, but it is believed those have been resolved through email discussions with Lou Volchansky and John Swigart.

6. RNP Concepts and Benefits AT

The team held a June 9th telecon and reviewed applications from last year. Also discussed was what does RNP bring to the table that RNAV does not. There will be a telecon June 23rd to discuss onboard performance and monitoring of RNP. The Team plans to look at previous recommendations from the CDWG and DSWG.

The team held a June 17th telecon and is reviewing the draft paper for structure and content. They are planning for a F2F meeting the afternoon of July 7th prior to the PARC F2F.
