

# **PARC Telecon Summary**

### **1. RNP SAAAR Update Action Team**

The Significant Change recommendations are available for comment on the KSN Site. The team will still make a couple of minor tweaks, but changes will be so minor that they will not affect the outcome. PARC Members should review the recommendations and be prepared to discuss them at the F2F with the goal of getting approval and the go-ahead to draft a recommendation letter.
