

PARC Telecon Summary

1. RNP SAAAR Update Action Team

Cramer

Two things are happening with the Team. First, the letter and recommendations for Appendix 3 “significant change” have been sent out for comment and are posted on the KSN site. The Team has received a few inputs for slight changes to the text which have been made. Next week the comments period closes and Mike Cramer will send a final copy to Dave Nakamura for transmittal to Ms. Gilligan. Second, the FAA has suggested that the folks involved in the new appendix 5 (training requirements) for AC 90-101 help review a couple of points that they have found in the new text that was provided by the action team. They are including that new material, but have some questions before they send it back into internal coordination. Mike Cramer and John Swigart have the action on this.

The Team had a large turnout for their November 4th meeting. Briefings by Sarah Dalton on the Seattle Greener Skies program and from Grady Boyce on the Atlanta project were given. Summary notes can be forwarded to the group. A few steps were outlined as to what is required to move forward with work. The Team wants to brief AOV at some point in the future to raise their awareness, and will include a safety assessment as part of that briefing. Mark Steinbicker requested that Steve Barnes or someone from his group to be involved in the AOV briefing. It was also said that it would be of great benefit to have the next Team meeting in OKC. The Team would also like to have a two day working session to discuss issues inherent in the operations involved in these two projects. They also need to do a preliminary hazard examination for both Atlanta and Seattle. A follow-on telecon planned for a week from now for the team leadership group. A request was made for an FAA co-chair for the Team. Dave Nakamura agreed with this request, and Mark Steinbicker stated that he will work on finding a suitable FAA rep.
