Subject:	Waiver to FAA Order 8260.3, Track Separation for Simultaneous Independent Procedures Considered Established on a PBN Segment of a Published Instrument Approach at Los Angeles International Airport (KLAX)

This memorandum authorizes waivers to FAA Order 8260.3E, United States Standard for Terminal Instrument Procedures (TERPS), Paragraph 15-5-3 for the following approaches:

RNAV (RNP) Z Rwy 6L	RNAV (RNP) Z Rwy 7L
RNAV (GPS) Y Rwy 6L	RNAV (GPS) Y Rwy 7L
RNAV (RNP) Z Rwy 6R	RNAV (RNP) Z Rwy 7R
RNAV (GPS) Y Rwy 6R	RNAV (GPS) Y Rwy 7R

The approaches do not provide unique tracks separated by at least 0.5 NM from other tracks for at least 50 seconds prior to crossing the first Final Approach Course (FAC). However, the worst case runway spacing of 4550 feet still meets section 15-1 simultaneous independent approach requirements. Using these approaches for EoR operations therefore does not increase the aircraft-to-aircraft collision risk to an unacceptable level.
