

Arriving at the Facility

All visitors will be screened at the Visitor Center, located at the back of the complex. Please follow the directional signs around the fence line to reach the Visitor Center. Visitors arriving by public transportation or private car service can be dropped off at the pedestrian entrance at the front of the building, where they will undergo screening in the lobby of the main building.

What identification will I need?

Upon entry, visitors must present a valid, non-expired, government-issued identification card. Acceptable forms of ID include a state-issued driver's license, a passport that has not exceeded its expiration date, a state ID, or a military identification card. It is crucial to note that without a valid government ID, visitors will be denied entry and will not be able to access the premises.

Visitor Screening Procedures

All visitors will be screened before entering the complex. Visitors who refuse to be screened will be denied access to the facility.

Visitor Escorting

Visitors must remain under continuous escort by personnel with a valid FAA ID throughout their visit to the Southern Regional Office. All visitors will receive a visitor badge that must be worn at all times while on the property. Visitors are required to return their badges at the end of each visit. The badge must be visible and worn below the neck and above the waist.

Parking Guidance

The security guards will guide you to the appropriate designated parking area for the event.

Accessibility Accommodations

If you need accessibility accommodations or have a certified service animal, please indicate during the registration process. All other animals are prohibited in the facility and cannot be left unattended in vehicles on the premises.

Prohibited Items

Weapons

Regardless of state laws or your rights to open carry, federal law prohibits anyone from possessing firearms, ammunition, knives, pepper spray, stun guns, deadly weapons, or hazardous materials in or on federal facilities, including in privately owned vehicles. Access to the facility will be denied if a suspicious item is found during screening.

Photography and Recording Guidance

Videography, photography, and voice recording are prohibited at all times inside and on the facility's grounds.
