The Average Daily Airport Capacity at the (FY 2008) Seven Metropolitan Areas for June 2008 was 35,931 which exceeds June's target of 33,676. The Average Daily Total Airport Capacity at the Seven Metropolitan Areas for fiscal year-to-date is GREEN at 35,989- above the annual target of 33,676. The Average Daily Total Airport Capacity at the (FY 2008) Seven Metropolitan Areas for June 2008 (35,931) decreased less than 1% from May 2008 (36,124) and increased 1.3% from June 2007 (35,464).

Another factor that impacted capacity at several major airports in the Metro 7 group during June 2008 was inclement weather. During the month of June 2008, wind, low ceilings, low visibility, thunderstorms, and rain impacted performance at EWR, JFK, LGA, ORD, and PHL. During the month of June 2008, wind, low ceilings, low visibility, thunderstorms, and rain impacted performance at EWR, JFK, LGA, ORD, and PHL. Total ground delay programs (GDP) for the month of June 2008 (114) increased 39% from May 2008 (82). Total GDP minutes for the month of June 2008 (2,097,947) increased 71.9% from the month of May 2008 (1,220,551). Total ground stops (GS) for the month of June 2008 (415) increased 94.8% from May 2008 (213). Total GS minutes for the month of June 2008 (195,601) increased 169.5% from the month of May 2008 (72,575).
