

# 13E1 FAA Ratings by Employees

## Description

The FAA is rated in the top 25 percent of places to work in the federal government by employees. FY13 Target: 75%

## Commentary (03/2013)

Recently, a decision was made to delay the launch of an FAA Executive Action Learning Team (ALT) because of the government sequestration and its impacts on the FAA. The FAA Executive ALT would be tasked with addressing the 2012 FAA Fedview results by identifying some actions to improve FAA's Fedview scores and ranking on Best Places To Work Index (BPTW). The government-wide 2013 Fedview Survey administration continues to move forward as evidenced by: - John Berry, Director of OPM issued a memorandum dated February 22, 2013 to Heads of Executive Departments and Agencies that announced the upcoming 2013 Fedview Survey administration and requested that agency leadership support and motivate their workforce to take the 2013 survey and take appropriate actions to address prior year's Fedview results. - OPM notified government-wide unions about the upcoming survey - DOT notified its unions about the 2013 Fedview and AHL provided courtesy notification to FAA unions. - AHR-1 signed a memo to the FAA Management Board announcing the upcoming 2013 Fedview and it is being distributed. - Whether FAA develops an action plan or not to improve its scores/ranking, OST has developed a DOT FY 2013-2014 Fedview Action Plan that was submitted to OMB/OPM in March. DOT received feedback from OPM/OMB on its Plan, which has led to possible revisions in the Plan and caused a delay in releasing the Plan to OAs. Operating Administrations will be expected to support the DOT Plan as well as implement their own actions. Guidance should be forthcoming on the DOT Fedview Action Plan.
