

## 14C.142D NAT: Fleet Management

### Description

Reduce FY-2014 agency petroleum consumption by government fleet vehicles by 18% from the FY-2005 baseline, a maximum consumption of 2,286,254 gasoline-equivalent units. In accordance with Executive Order 13514, federal agencies must reduce vehicle fleet petroleum consumption at a minimum of 2% annually through FY-2020, relative to a FY-2005 baseline.

### Commentary (September 2014)

FAA petroleum consumption through August (September data not available until after October 15) is trending in a significantly more positive direction than the preceding four years. Petroleum reduction is attributed to reduced inventory, careful replacement selection over the past several years, and the communication campaign that recently concluded. FAA is currently on track to go "Green". FAA projects an end of year petroleum consumption reduction of 21% from our FY 2005 baseline well above the target of 18% reduction. ATO is very close to meeting their FY 14 annual target for reduction, but if trends continue they should meet the end year FY 14 annual reduction target, however, final FY 14 data will not be available for analysis and reporting until late October.

### Commentary (August 2014)

FAA petroleum consumption through July (August data not available until after September 15) is trending in a significantly more positive direction than the preceding four years. Petroleum reduction is attributed to reduced inventory, careful replacement selection over the past several years, and the communication campaign that recently concluded. FAA is currently on track to go "Green". FAA projected end of year petroleum consumption is 21% (assuming equal consumption each month of the year) well above the target of 18% reduction. FAA petroleum consumption has dropped 1% each of the past few months - we anticipate a final reduction of 19%.
