

16E.7 Hiring Persons with Targeted Disabilities (PWTD)

Description

Support the DOT Strategic Objective to build a capable, diverse, and collaborative workforce of highly-skilled, innovative, and motivated employees by increasing the hiring of PWTD for eligible positions to 3 percent by 2018. In FY 2016, ACR in collaboration with the FAA LOBs/SOs will ensure that at least 2.33% of all FAA new hires are PWTD.

Commentary (March 2016)

Currently the FAA has hired 1489 employees and of that 9 are People with Targeted Disabilities (PWTD) for a .60% hiring rate. This is currently below the 2.33% goal, ACR is working with the PWTD Tiger Team to develop strategies to increase the hiring of PWTD for FY16.

Commentary (February 2016)

Currently the FAA has hired 1214 employees and of that 7 are People with Targeted Disabilities (PWTD) for a .58% hiring rate. This is currently below the 2.33% goal, ACR is working with the PWTD Tiger Team to develop strategies to increase the hiring of PWTD for FY16.
