Notice to Parents/Guardians - COPPA Consent

Authority: Information solicited by the Smartsheet - Create A STEM/AVSED (Airport Design Challenge) User Profile is authorized by the Children’s Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998 (COPPA), 15 U.S.C. 6501-6506 (2001); Airport and Airway Development Act of 1970, Public Law 94-353; National and Community Service Act of 1990, 49 U.S.C. § 12501; and Title VI: Aviation Workforce of the FAA Reauthorization Act of 2018 (Public Law 115-254).

Purpose: To enable participation in the FAA’s Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) and Aviation and Space Education (AVSED) Airport Design Challenge, the parent/legal guardian will provide their name, email address, phone number, and home address. In addition, for each child who will participate in the FAA’s STEM and AVSED Airport Design Challenge, the parent/legal guardian will provide that child’s name and email address. The parent/legal guardian is required to provide signed consent for their children’s participation in the STEM and AVSED mentor cohort. The parent/guardian will also be required to sign a Children Online Privacy Protection Act form prior to their child participation in the STEM or AVSED program.

Routine Uses: In accordance with the Privacy Act system of records notice, [DOT/FAA 855, Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math \(STEM\) Aviation and Space Education Outreach Program, 87 FR 73066 \(November 28, 2022\)](#), this information is routinely:

- Used to identify, verify, and obtain consent of the parent or legal guardian for their child to attend an educational program.
- Shared with other individuals or organizations, including Federal, State, or local agencies, and nonprofit, educational and private entities who are participating in FAA STEM programs as necessary for the purpose of assisting FAA in the efficient administration of its program.
- Shared with educational institutions or training providers as evidence of participation or successful completion, as needed to continue education.
