Ceilings are in feet above airport elevation. Distances are in nautical miles. Visibilities are in statute miles or feet RVR unless otherwise indicated.

LIGHT POLE 942 FT FROM DER, 453 FT RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, 39 FT AGL/145 FT MSL. TREES BEGINNING 307 FT FROM DER, 26 LEFT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 58 FT AGL/165 FT MSL.
