Bearings, headings, courses, tracks and radials are magnetic. Elevation and altitudes are in feet MSL. Altitudes are minimum altitudes unless otherwise indicated.
Ceilings are in feet above airport elevation. Distances are in nautical miles. Visibilities are in statute miles or feet RVR unless otherwise indicated.

NOTE: RWY 4, VEHICLES ON ROAD BEGINNING 192 FT FROM DER, CROSSING LEFT TO RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 15 FT AGL/754 FT MSL. TREES BEGINNING 380 FEET FROM DER, 276 FT RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100 FT AGL/849 FT MSL. BLDG 410 FT FROM DER, 225 FT LEFT OF CENTERLINE, 30 FT AGL/759 FT MSL.

NOTE: RWY 15, TREES BEGINNING 470 FT FROM DER, 461 FT LEFT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100 FT AGL/869 FT MSL. TREES BEGINNING 568 FT FROM DER, 187 FT RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100' AGL/869 FT MSL.
