Bearings, headings, courses, tracks and radials are magnetic. Elevation and altitudes are in feet MSL. Altitudes are minimum altitudes unless otherwise indicated.
Ceilings are in feet above airport elevation. Distances are in nautical miles. Visibilities are in statute miles or feet RVR unless otherwise indicated.

RWY 36: STANDARD
RWY 18: 300-1 OR STANDARD WITH MINIMUM CLIMB OF 511 FT PER NM TO 1000.

RWY 36: CLIMBING RIGHT TURN HEADING 066.00 AND ON LYH R-005 OUTBOUND TO 3500 BEFORE PROCEEDING ON COURSE.
RWY 18: CLIMB HEADING 175.53 TO 2200 BEFORE PROCEEDING ON COURSE.

TAKEOFF OBSTACLE NOTES:

NOTE: RWY 36, TREES BEGINNING AT DER, LEFT AND RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100 FT AGL / 979 FT MSL. VEHICLE ON ROADWAY, 19 FT FROM DER, 186 FT LEFT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 15 FT AGL / 894 FT MSL.
NOTE: RWY 18, TREES BEGINNING AT DER, LEFT AND RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100 FT AGL / 919 FT MSL.
