Ceilings are in feet above airport elevation. Distances are in nautical miles. Visibilities are in statute miles or feet RVR unless otherwise indicated.

NOTE: RWY 8, TRAIN ON TRACKS, 624 FT FROM DER, LEFT AND RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 23 FT AGL/4087 FT MSL. TERRAIN BEGINNING 35 FT FROM DER, LEFT AND RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, 4064 FT MSL. VEHICLES ON ROAD, 794 FT FROM DER, LEFT AND RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 17 FT AGL/4081 FT MSL.

NOTE: RWY 19, TERRAIN BEGINNING 13 FT FROM DER, LEFT AND RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, 4080 FT MSL.

NOTE: RWY 26, TERRAIN BEGINNING 15 FT FROM DER, LEFT AND RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, 4074 FT MSL.
