Ceilings are in feet above airport elevation. Distances are in nautical miles. Visibilities are in statute miles or feet RVR unless otherwise indicated.

RWY 23, TREES BEGINNING 77 FT FROM DER, 259 FT LEFT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 75 FT AGL/1324 FT MSL. TREES BEGINNING 127 FT FROM DER, 326 FT RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 36 FT AGL/1285 FT MSL.
