Ceilings are in feet above airport elevation. Distances are in nautical miles. Visibilities are in statute miles or feet RVR unless otherwise indicated.

**NOTE: RWY 14,** VEHICLES ON ROAD BEGINNING 1020 FT FROM DER, ON CENTERLINE, 15 FT AGL/814 FT MSL. TREES AND POWER POLES BEGINNING AT DER, 75 FT RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100 FT AGL/ 879 FT MSL. TREES, POWER POLES, LIGHT POLES AND VEHICLES ON ROAD BEGINNING AT DER, 251 FT LEFT ON CENTERLINE, UP TO 100 FT AGL/899 FT MSL.

**NOTE: RWY 32,** TRAIN ON RAILROAD TRACKS, TRMSN POLES AND TREE BEGINNING 339 FT FROM DER, 107 FT RIGHT ON CENTERLINE, 76 FT AGL/845 FT MSL. TREES, VEHICLES ON ROAD AND BUSH BEGINNING 14 FT FROM DER, 198 FT LEFT ON CENTERLINE, UP TO 46 FT AGL/815 FT MSL.
