# TAKEOFF MINIMUMS AND OBSTACLE DEPARTURE PROCEDURES (ODP)

Bearings, headings, courses, tracks, and radials are magnetic. Elevations and altitudes are in feet, MSL. Altitudes are minimum altitudes unless otherwise indicated. Cellings are in feet above airport elevation. Distances are in nautical miles. Visibilities are in statute miles or feet RVR unless otherwise indicated.

### (1) TAKEOFF MINIMUMS:

**RWY 26. STANDARD.** 

RWY 8, 300-1 1/4 OR STANDARD WITH MINIMUM CLIMB OF 221 FEET PER NM TO 1700, OR ALTERNATIVELY, WITH STANDARD TAKEOFF MINIMUMS AND A NORMAL 200 FT/NM CLIMB GRADIENT, TAKEOFF MUST OCCUR NO LATER THAN 1600 FEET PRIOR TO DEPARTURE END OF RUNWAY.

## (2) TEXTUAL DEPARTURE PROCEDURE:

RWY 8 - CLIMB HEADING 080.19 TO 2100 BEFORE TURNING RIGHT.

NOTE: RWY 8, TREES BEGINNING 24' FROM DER, 139' RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100' AGL/1639' MSL. TREES BEGINNING 37' FROM DER, 115' LEFT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100' AGL/1619' MSL. VEHICLES ON ROAD BEGINNING 217' FROM DER, ON CENTERLINE, UP TO 15' AGL/1514' MSL. NOTE: RWY 26, TREES BEGINNING 4' FROM DER, 64' RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100' AGL/1579' MSL. TREES BEGINNING 32' FROM DER, 81' LEFT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100' AGL/1579' MSL.
