

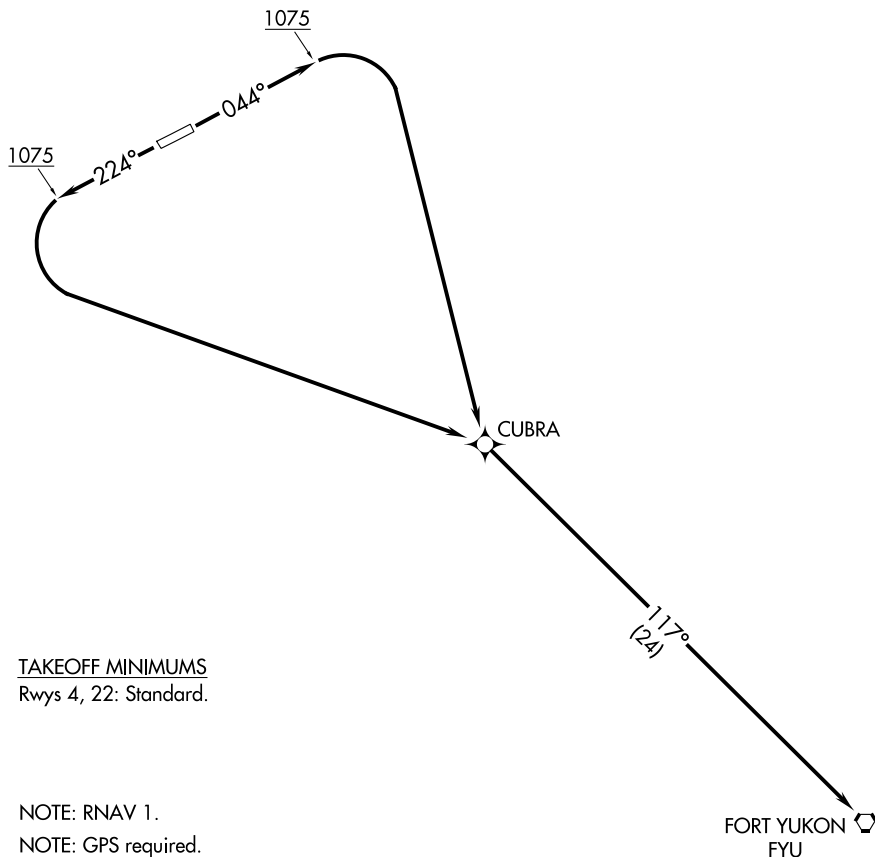

...on track 117° to FYU VORTAC, maintain ATC assigned altitude, expect filed altitude 10 minutes after departure.
