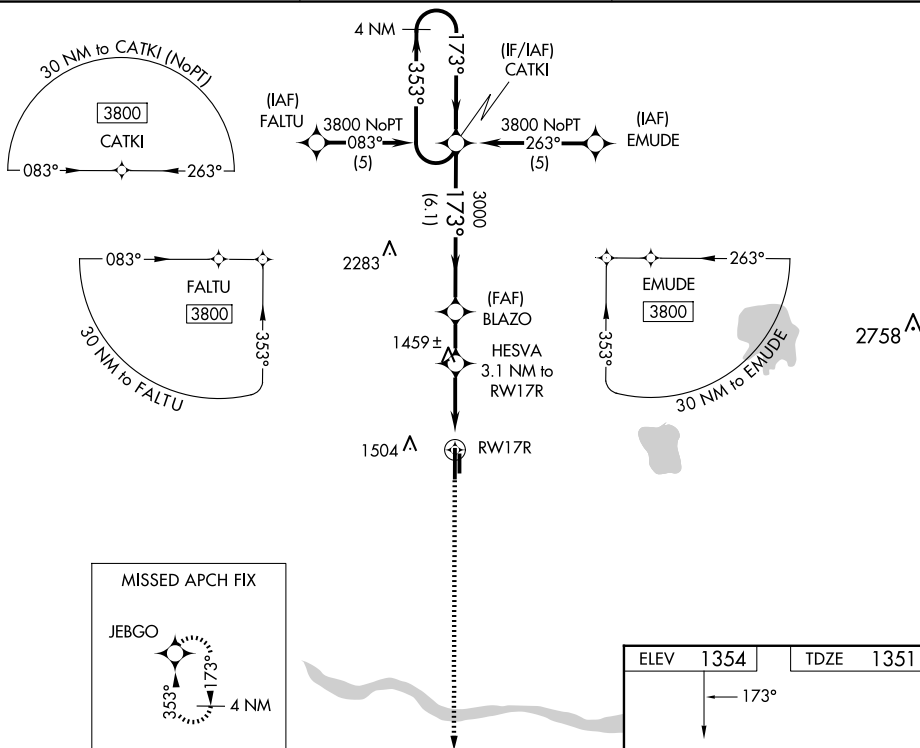
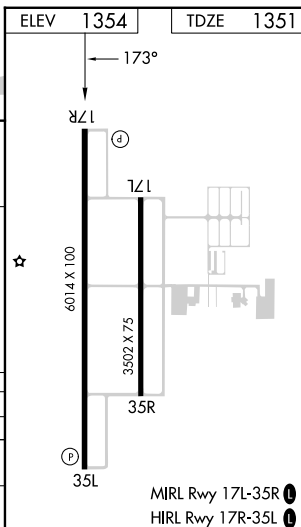

Diagram illustrating the RNAV glidepath for CATKI. The glidepath is defined by a 3.00° angle (TCH 52). Key distances and points are marked:

- GP 3.00° TCH 52**: Glidepath angle and threshold crossing height.
- CATKI**: Initial point of the glidepath.
- BLAZO**: Point where the glidepath intersects the 3000 MSL altitude.
- HESVA**: Point 3.1 NM to RW17R.
- RW17R**: Runway 17 Right.
- Distances along the glidepath**: 4.1 NM, 1.9 NM, 2 NM, and 1.1 NM.
- Altitudes**: 3800 MSL and 3000 MSL.
- Angles**: 353° and 173° at CATKI; 173° at BLAZO.
- Navigation Mode**: *RNAV only.
- Obstacle**: JEBGO (JEBGO Obstacle) is shown as a diamond symbol.
